VERBIAGE & NOTES

- WOF - Width of Fabric.
- Seam allowance - $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.
- Pattern makes a throw size measuring 50 x 74".

- RTS - Right Sides Together.

Please read through all directions before beginning!

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 5 focal prints, preferably larger scale, $\frac{3}{8}$ yds each.
- Coordinating solid for sashing and border, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yds.

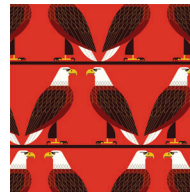
CUTTING

- For 5 focal prints, cut into (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.
- For sashing and border solid, cut into (5) 2" x WOF strips & (6) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

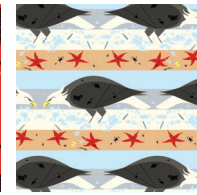
ASSEMBLY

- Sew together main focal prints with (1) 2" x WOF sashing strip in between each 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF main focal prints.
- Add (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF border piece on the top and bottom.
- Sew together (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF border pieces on the short side to create side border piece. Repeat for the other side. Sew to each side, press seams. Trim down and square up the side border pieces after sewing.
- That's it! You're done with this super simple and instantly gratifying quilt top, to show off your large scale prints!

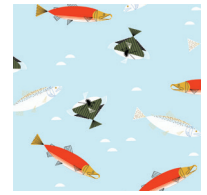

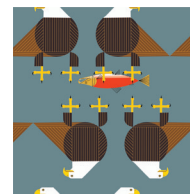

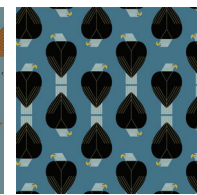
